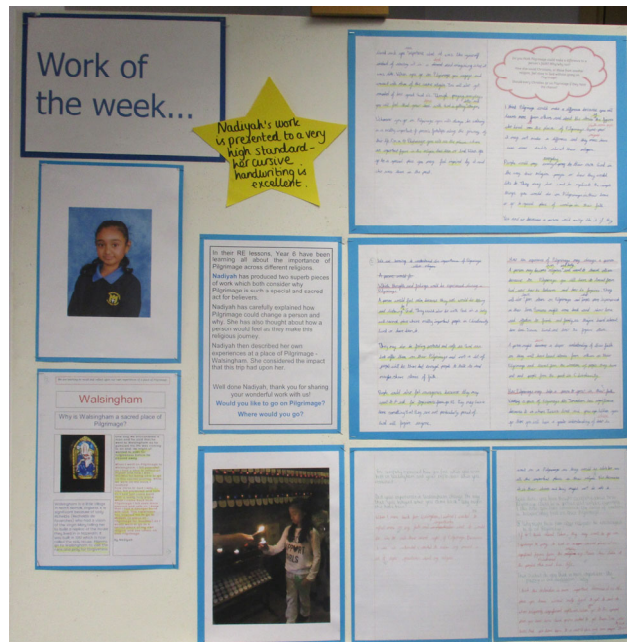

In their RE lessons Year 6 have been learning about Pilgrimage in different religions.

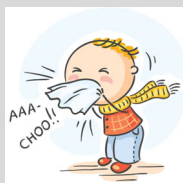
Nadiyah has produced two superb pieces of work considering why pilgrimage is a special and sacred act for believers.
