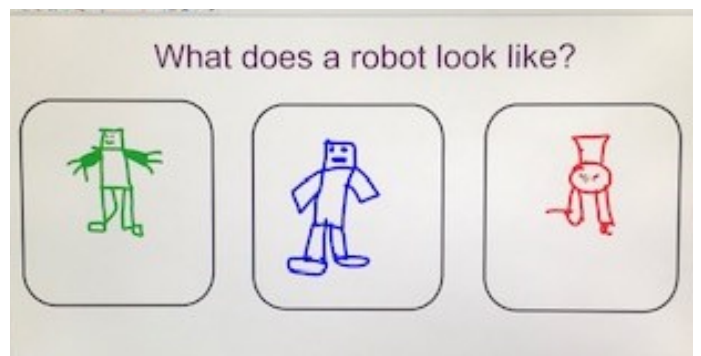
Last week Year 5 had a fantastic visit to the CLC.
